



Dance Unlimited Rules and Information

- Students will be respectful of themselves, each other, the instructor, the facility and parents.
- Students will need to be dressed appropriately for their class each week. Including appropriate foot attire.
- Students will arrive on time for class.
- Students and parents will be a positive example. Classes will be a place all dancers feel comfortable and safe. Students should represent DSDU in a positive manner at all dance events. Unacceptable behavior will not be tolerated in class, at competitions, at community events, etc. A student may be removed from the DSDU Team for inappropriate behavior.
- Students will have the opportunity to showcase what they learn and will be expected to purchase a costume.
- Students should not bring valuable items to dance. DSDU cannot be held responsible for lost or stolen items.
- Information may be disseminated in multiple ways including: posted at the studio, text, email, calls, the DSDU webpage and the DSDU Facebook Page.

Enrollment Fee, Monthly Tuition, Costume Costs, Competition Fees, Recital Fee, and Withdrawing from DSDU

The DSDU August enrollment fee is \$25.00 per student and is a one-time fee per dance year. The student's DSDU performance t-shirt is included in the enrollment fee. The enrollment fee is \$15.00 in January if the dancer enrolls only for the Spring semester. A studio shirt will not be included in the spring fee.

When you enroll in a year of dance you may pay the entire year in full or pay in monthly installments. The amount of tuition is determined by the number of classes the student enrolls in. Tuition will not be prorated or discounted if a student does not come to class during any given month of the year. Tuition is \$45.00 per month for a 30-minute class and \$50.00 per month for a 45-minute class. If the student participates in additional classes, the cost is \$25.00 per month for a second 30-minute class and \$25.00 per month for an additional 45-minute class.

Tuition is also discounted for siblings per class. ****Tuition is due by the students' 1st class of each month. ****

****If tuition is not paid by the 10th day of the month a \$10.00 late fee will be assessed on the 11th for each month the tuition is past due. ** If the tuition is more than 2 months past due, the student will not be allowed to participate in class.** All past due amounts will need to be paid before a student can enroll.****

Costumes- Payment Due in October

DSDU costume fees: \$65.00 for each 30-minute class and non-competitive classes.

\$85.00 for each 45-minute class and competitive classes.

****All costume payments are due with October tuition. **** If the costume payment is not made before the costumes are ordered, a costume WILL NOT be ordered for the student. If the costume must be ordered after December, a \$20.00 fee will be added to the costume fee.

Competition dates, fees and fee due dates will be announced before the competition season. All regional fees will be due at least one month prior to the first competition. National fees will be due with April tuition.

*****Recital Fee***** Each student will pay a \$25.00 Recital Fee. The fee will be due with March tuition.

No credits or refunds will be given for any classes, costumes, competitions or recitals not attended by the student.

*****All Payments are due by the students' first class of the month. *****

Online payments can be made through the DSDU payment portal. Checks should be made out to DSDU. You may drop your payment in the mailbox inside the DSDU Royalty Room or give your payment to your instructor. Receipts will be given for cash payments only when requested.

*****Covid-19 Information***** Tuition will not be credited, returned or prorated due to illness or quarantine.

*****Termination of Classes***** In the event you choose to terminate your classes with DSDU, notification must be submitted in writing two weeks before the student's last class. Students who attend at least one class during the month will be charged full tuition for the month.

Classes, Holidays and Bad Weather

Students should not be dropped off more than 5 minutes prior to their class time and should be picked up at the time their class ends. Students may wait in the lobby if they have more than one class or if they have a break between two. While in the lobby, students are expected to be courteous of others and be on their best behavior.

All Holidays observed by Durant ISD will be observed by DS Dance Unlimited. Please visit the Durant ISD Calendar for days we will not have dance due to Holidays. Classes will meet on Parent Teacher Conference Nights.

In the event of bad weather, classes will not meet. If Durant Schools close early or are closed for the day due to inclement weather, DSDU will not meet that evening for dance. If the school is not closed, and bad weather is predicted for the night, a post will be made on the DSDU Facebook page, with a decision to meet or cancel for the evening.

Class Viewing

Parents may view the class through the viewing window. If time allows, parents will be invited into the dance studio at the end of class in order to see your student's progress. Please be courteous of all learning styles.
